



600,000 allergic people



40.6 M€ of health care costs









### **ANSES Opinion**

Risk analysis relating to the giant ragweed (Ambrosia trifida L.) in order to formulate management recommendations (2017)

- "Impact on contaminated plots is very rapid and can result in the total loss of the harvest and additional management costs for the plot".
- "A. trifida contributes to the presence in the atmosphere of allergenic pollen that will only aggravate the issue of pollen-related allergies"









MINISTÈRE DES SOLIDARITÉS ET DE LA SANTÉ **2017:** Publication of a **decree** about management of three *Ambrosia sp.* 

→ obligation to destroy *Ambrosia sp.* in all habitats

Ambrosia psilostachya DC.













# Specific Ambrosia trifida actions

- less widespread
  - management recommendations The French Agency for Food, Environmental and Occupational Health & Safety (Anses)

=> In 2018, different partners started a "<u>citizen science</u>" mission to gather better information about the repartition of the plant.



### Map of detection of Ambrosia trifida on Flora Data


















WARNING AMBROSIA WARNING AMBROSIA

- Ambrosia artemisiifolia: real issue in France
- Ambrosia trifida: emerging organism associated with high risks
- New legislation framework : Obligation to destroy three *Ambrosia* species
- Management at different scales:
  - ✓ Local referent
  - ✓ Departmental referent
  - ✓ French Ragweed Observatory (National resources center on ragweed species)
- Lot of things to do
- Coordination of all protagonists is essential!
