Before the end of December, Michel will transfer the amount on the IRS French personal bank account to the official bank account of Post Finance in Switzerland. The president must ask to the bank with a copy of the General Assembly with the information of the new president and the treasurers. This must be done in January.

### List of IRS members and subscriptions for next year

It is not possible for the moment to subscribe but Gilles has prepared a project of registration form, which will be available soon on the website (after validation by the treasurer and president). The payment will be directly by bank transfer to Post Finance. The possibility to use Alphavisa for the membership registration and payment has been stopped. Alphavisa sent the latest version of the members list.

# 2) Increasing the attractiveness of IRS

### a. Research funding

It has been decided to try to identify research questions that could bring together researchers from different disciplines and serve as a basis for the application to research funding. The idea is that a significant international research project is key to attracting new members. Heinz, Uwe, Arnaud and László have proposed questions in a prepared google document. Here are the discussed possible topics:

- Ophraella post-introduction monitoring, impacts and natural enemies
- Ragweed evolution and hybridization
- Reproductive allocation in common ragweed
- Combination of management techniques (including biocontrol)
- Ragweed distribution and citizen science (including plant-insect occurrences\*)
- Knowledge gaps and priorization in management
- Decision making in relation to invasion situation, health problems and costs
- Communication on the topic
- Ragweed response to increased CO2 and impact on pollen, possibly using of a space-for-time approach (e.g. along urbanity gradient) and novel 'local' pollen traps.
- One-health approach

\*Note: Recording interactions in iNtauralist: plant animal interactions are possible to record in citizen science portals, such as iNaturalist. This is however not straightforward, as those platforms are primarily made for single species occurrence reporting. The general idea is 1) to add a description field (such as "animal-plant interaction" in addition to "species", "location", etc.) with the other species as a descriptor; or 2) to make separate observations (one for species 1 and another for species 2) and link them with a keyword. In both case it is most probably useful for trained people rather than lambda citizens.

Maybe we should write a document to be published as a White paper about all the issues involved with ragweed with One Health approach.

In addition, a call to people involved in Cost SMARTER could also help. Providing Gilles with "news" on our ragweed activity can also be useful to attract interest.

## b. Ambrosia meetings (or "Ambrosia readings)

A proposition to increase the attractiveness of IRS is to organize some "Ambrosia meetings" online to share ideas, project, informations.

Propositions made:

- Ophraella communa project in France: Inrae and CSIRO testing panel of vegetal hosts (Nicolas Desneux and Vincent Lesieur)
- The most important allergens of Ambrosia and reasons why they cause allergy (Victoria)
- How citizen science can help to control ragweed and why it is important for people to carry on the control of *Ambrosia* habitats. (Arnaud Monty ? maybe someone else)

#### c. Other propositions
